## 10th Exmoor Archaeology Forum

Moorland Village Hall, Wheddon Cross  
Saturday 17 July 2010

**This is the tenth in a series of events looking at the archaeology and history of Exmoor. In 2010 the Exmoor Archaeology Forum is being run to coincide with the Festival of British Archaeology. This year we will be investigating the evidence for Iron Age and Roman Exmoor.**

Iron Age and Roman Exmoor (700BC – AD410) is poorly understood, but recent work is extending our knowledge of the period. The day will focus on recent projects and will include fieldwork and excavation within Exmoor National Park, Devon and the Quantock Hills.

We will look at the context of Exmoor at this time and will examine a range of evidence from Exmoor itself including Iron Age hill-slope enclosures, Roman military sites and the evidence for the iron industry.

The 10<sup>th</sup> Exmoor Archaeology Forum will comprise a series of illustrated talks by some of those involved in current fieldwork.
